

The Burma Post Office under Japanese Occupation 1942-45: The Roberts Papers, edited by Alan Meech & Richard Warren

In 1945, as Allied forces recaptured Burma, Brigadier G L Roberts obtained a cache of postal documents issued during the period of occupation from a local postmistress.

Now the documents Roberts acquired are published in their entirety along with some helpful supplementary material. They reveal much that is new: postage rates, aspects of stamps and stationery, extensive lists of post offices reopened and insights into the workings of a postal service during war and occupation.
